**ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTIVE SRCAD2010 – 5**

*(Amends Administrative Directive 2010-1)*

**IN RE: CIRCUIT DIVISION ASSIGNMENT CHANGES – SANTA ROSA COUNTY**

WHEREAS, a new Circuit Judge has been assigned to Santa Rosa County, Florida, effective October 1, 2010,

WHEREAS, Administrative Directive 2010-1 defines the circuit and county judges division assignments within the county, and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of judicial economy and utilization of the circuit judges to adjust the circuit assignments within the county, it is therefore

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that Administrative Directive 2010-1 is hereby amended by changing the division assignments as follows:

1. Circuit Court Division C will be assigned to Judge Rimmer;
2. Circuit Court Division D will be assigned to Judge Miller; and
3. Circuit Court Division E will be assigned to the Magistrate.

Except as described above, Administrative Directive 2010-1 remains unchanged and in full force and effect.

The foregoing assignments shall be effective November 1, 2010.
