MEDIATIONS PURSUANT TO ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

WHEREAS, First Judicial Circuit Administrative Order 2012-09 ordered the cancellation of the First Judicial Circuit Residential Mortgage Foreclosure Mediation Program effective February 29, 2012; and

WHEREAS the First Judicial Circuit Program Manager, the Collins Center, was ordered to resolve all pending cases in the program at the time of the cancellation on or before June 30, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Collins Center has notified the undersigned there are pending mediations that have been affected by delay that cannot be concluded on or before June 30, 2012, it is

ORDERED that:

1. An extension of the deadline imposed in Administrative Order No. 2012-09 upon the resolution of any case properly referred to the

Collins Center by order of Administrative Order No. 2010-01 shall be **granted.**

2. Any case properly referred to the Collins Center under Administrative Order No. 2010-01 that remains pending at the entry of this administrative order shall be resolved on or before **August 31, 2012.**
