**IN RE: GRAND JURY
SCHEDULING AND IMPANELMENT OF THE GRAND JURY**

ORDER

WHEREAS, it is the duty and responsibility of the Circuit Judges in the First Judicial Circuit to impanel and convene the Grand Jury in each of the respective counties pursuant to Chapter 905, *Florida Statutes*.

WHEREAS, the scheduling of the Grand Jury term has been vested in the Chief Judge by Section 905.01(3) (2013), *Florida Statutes*, it is

ORDERED that:

1. All Grand Juries existing in the First Judicial Circuit at the entry of this order shall be adjourned and desist effective December 31, 2013.
2. Effective January 1, 2014 all Grand Juries in the First Judicial Circuit shall be appointed for a six (6) month term.
3. Pursuant to the provisions of section 905.01(3), each County within the First Judicial Circuit shall impanel a Grand Jury during the first two weeks in January and the first two weeks in July to serve for a six (6) month term.
