be adjourned and desist effective December 31, 2013.

2. Effective January 1, 2014 all Grand Juries in the First Judicial Circuit shall be

appointed for a six (6) month term.

3. Pursuant to the provisions of section 905.01(3), each County within the First

Judicial Circuit shall impanel a Grand Jury during the first two weeks in January

and the first two weeks in July to serve for a six (6) month term.
