ORDER

WHEREAS, it officially has been made known to me that it is necessary to appoint a referee pursuant to rule 3-7.6(a), *Rules Regulating The Florida Bar*, to preside in a contempt of court action brought by The Florida Bar in the matter of

it is, therefore;

ORDERED that the Honorable Ross Goodman is hereby appointed to act as referee to conduct a case management conference, to be held no later than sixty (60) days from the date of appointment, at which the schedule for the proceedings, including the final hearing date, shall be set. The referee shall thereafter hear, conduct, try and determine matters which shall be presented at the final hearing, and thereafter shall submit findings of fact and recommendations to the Supreme Court of Florida as provided in Rule 3-7.6(m). The referee shall also act on all motions forwarded to the referee from the Supreme Court. Pursuant to Rule 3-7.6(m)(1), any order by the referee regarding disposition of the case shall be merely a recommendation to the Supreme Court. Such an order shall not dispose of the proceedings. The Supreme Court shall review and, if appropriate, approve the referee's recommended disposition order.

The referee's report shall be filed within one hundred eighty (180) days from December 10, 2013.
