it is, therefore:

ORDERED that the Honorable Patricia Grinsted is hereby appointed to act as referee. The referee shall hear argument concerning the appropriate sanction to be imposed and file a report and recommendation with the Supreme Court of Florida as provided in Rule 3-7.2(h)(2). Pursuant to Rule 3-7.6(m)(1), any order by the referee regarding the imposition of sanctions shall be merely a recommendation to the Supreme Court. Such an order shall not dispose of the proceedings. The Supreme Court shall review and, if appropriate, approve the referee's recommended sanction.

The referee's report shall be filed within **one hundred eighty (180) days** from July 24, 2014.
