Monday, September 7, 2020 - Labor Day
Monday, September 28, 2020 - Yom Kippur
Wednesday, November 11, 2020 - Veterans Day
Thursday, November 26, 2020 - Thanksgiving Day
Friday, November 27, 2020 - Friday after Thanksgiving Day
Thursday, December 24, 2020 - Christmas Eve
Friday, December 25, 2020 - Christmas Day

2. Pursuant to §43.26 and §43.27, *Florida Statutes*, all Clerks of the Courts in the First Judicial Circuit must provide appropriate staff in support of the Clerk's official duties and responsibilities to the judicial processes when courts in the First Judicial Circuit are open to the

public for business.
