**RE: COURT ADMINISTRATION
COURT HOLIDAY CLOSURES - 2021**

WHEREAS pursuant to SCPR 4.07 the courts are mandated to close for business in observance of certain holiday events; and

WHEREAS the undersigned Chief Judge is authorized to designate certain other dates for closure during each calendar year; it is

ORDERED that:

1. The Courts of the First Judicial Circuit will be closed to the public the following calendar dates in the year 2021:

**Friday, January 1, 2021 - New Year's Day
Monday, January 18, 2021 - Martin Luther King's Birthday
Monday, February 15, 2021 - Presidents' Day
Friday, April 2, 2021 - Good Friday
Monday, May 31, 2021 - Memorial Day
Monday, July 5, 2021 - Observance of Independence Day
Monday, September 6, 2021 - Labor Day
Tuesday, September 7, 2021 - Rosh Hashanah
Thursday, September 16, 2021 - Yom Kippur
Thursday, November 11, 2021 - Veterans Day
Thursday, November 25, 2021 - Thanksgiving Day
Friday, November 26, 2021 - Friday after Thanksgiving Day
Friday, December 24, 2021 - Observance of Christmas Day**

2. Pursuant to §43.26 and §43.27, *Florida Statutes*, all Clerks of the Courts in the First Judicial Circuit must provide appropriate staff in support of the Clerk's official duties and

responsibilities to the judicial processes when courts in the First Judicial Circuit are open to the public for business.
