**ORDER ON COMPLIANCE WITH RULE 2.215(f)**

**WHEREAS** Rule 2.215(f), *Florida Rules of Judicial Administration* reads:

- (f) **Duty to Rule within a Reasonable Time.** Every judge has a duty to rule upon and announce an order or judgment on every matter submitted to that judge within a reasonable time. Each judge shall maintain a log of cases under advisement and inform the chief judge of the circuit at the end of each calendar month of each case that has been held under advisement for more than 60 days.

**ORDERED AND ADJUDGED** that

The procedure for the First Judicial Circuit in complying with *Rule 2.215(f)* will, effective immediately, be as follows:

1. Each judge of the First Judicial Circuit will inform the Chief Judge by the fifth day of each following month of any and all cases under advisement in excess of 60 days.
2. When submitting a report to the Chief Judge, First Judicial Circuit judges will use the attached reporting form.
3. A monthly report shall not be filed if a judge has zero cases under advisement in excess of 60 days.
4. This order replaces and vacates Administrative Order No. 2005-30.
