**IN RE: FIRST JUDICIAL CIRCUIT RESIDENTIAL MORTGAGE
FORECLOSURE MEDIATION PROGRAM - EXTENDING
TIME TO CONCLUDE PENDING MEDIATIONS PURSUANT
TO ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 2012-09**

WHEREAS, First Judicial Circuit Administrative Order 2012-09 ordered the cancellation of the First Judicial Circuit Residential Mortgage Foreclosure Mediation Program effective February 29, 2012; and

WHEREAS the First Judicial Circuit Program Manager, the Collins Center, was ordered to resolve all pending cases in the program at the time of the cancellation on or before June 30, 2012 extended to August 31, 2012; and

WHEREAS, the Collins Center has notified the undersigned there are pending mediations that have been affected by delay that cannot be concluded on or before June 30, 2012, extended to August 31, 2012, it is:

ORDERED that:

1. An extension of the deadline imposed in Administrative Order No.2012-09 for the resolution of any case properly referred to the

Collins Center pursuant to Administrative Order No. 2010-01 shall be granted as to the following individual cases from Escambia, Santa Rosa, and Walton Counties:

 - C. Deutsche Bank National Trust Company vs. Leonard Willsey, 4607 CA 005464.
 - D. The Bank of New York Mellon, fka The Bank of New York as Trustee for the Certificate holders of the Cwabs, Inc., Asset-backed Certificates, Series 2005-Ab5 vs. Michael Hapster, 4612 CA 000897.
 - E. US Bank National Association, as Trustee for Citigroup Mortgage Loan Trust 2006, 2Wfhe4 vs. Martin Greenway, 6610 CA 001208.
2. The Collins Center shall have until September 30, 2012, to complete mediation of the above listed cases, and no further extensions will be granted.
