**APPELLATE PROCEDURE FOR COUNTY COURT APPEALS  
IN ESCAMBIA COUNTY**

WHEREAS, after careful review of the three judge appellate panel system, which has been utilized by this county for many years, and;

WHEREAS, in order to better utilize the judicial resources of the Circuit Court in Escambia County and to expedite the appellate process for county court appeals, it is

ORDERED that:

1. The appellate panels for Escambia County shall consist of one (1) judge each.
2. The Administrative Judge for Escambia County shall issue such administrative directives as may be necessary to give full effect to this order.
