ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that any money collected for court-ordered restitution, which cannot be disbursed to the victim(s) due to the inability to locate said victim(s), shall be forwarded to Florida's Crimes Compensation, and the balance of all restitution owed to said victim(s) shall be transferred to the Crimes Compensation Account for future collection of court-ordered restitution for said victim(s).
