**APPELLATE PROCEDURE FOR COUNTY COURT APPEALS
IN SANTA ROSA COUNTY**

WHEREAS, after careful review of the three judge appellate panel system presently being used in Santa Rosa County, and;

WHEREAS, in order to better utilize the judicial resources of the Circuit Court in Santa Rosa County and to expedite the appellate process for county court appeals, it is

ORDERED that:

1. Effective November 1, 2005, the appellate panels for Santa Rosa County shall consist of one (1) judge each.
2. The Administrative Judge for Santa Rosa County shall issue such administrative directives as may be necessary to give full effect to this order.
