**IN RE: PRISONERS' AFFIDAVITS OF INDIGENCY**

**WHEREAS**, Administrative Directive ECAD1997-01 dated January 29, 1997 requires under paragraph II, page 2, that the affidavit be notarized; and

**WHEREAS**, Sec. 57.085(2), *Florida Statutes*, does not require formal notarization of the affidavit; it is

**ORDERED THAT:**

Administrative Directive ECAD1997-01, paragraph II, page 2 is hereby amended to read as follows:

The affidavit must contain the following oath:

“I am unable to pay court costs and fees. Under penalty of perjury, I swear or affirm that all statements in this affidavit are true and complete.”

In all other aspects Administrative Directive ECAD1997-01 remains in full force and effect.
