**RE: INTOXILYZER 8000, SERIAL #80-000751
MOTIONS PENDING IN COUNTY COURT**

WHEREAS, Motions to Suppress the results of the Intoxilyzer 8000, Serial #80-000751, or evidence of refusals to submit to a breath test on that instrument have been filed in the various divisions of the County Courts in Escambia County, Florida, and

WHEREAS, the grounds of such motions all involve the status of the dry gas cylinder on the Intoxilyzer 8000, Serial #80-000751 during the same time period, and

WHEREAS, judicial economy and consistency would best be served setting these motions before a single division of the County Court, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that all Motions to Suppress filed in the County Court of Escambia County, Florida and the discovery issues relating thereto as to the status of the dry gas cylinder of the Intoxilyzer 8000, Serial #80-000751 are assigned to Division 3 of the Escambia County Court for disposition. The rulings made by Division 3 of the Escambia County Court shall be binding upon all divisions of such court in the respective cases.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that all attorneys requesting to be heard on these motions shall contact Division 3 (Judge David B. Ackerman) to schedule a hearing date or dates involving this matter.
