**ESCAMBIA COUNTY ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTIVE
ECAD2015-03**

IN RE: THE TEMPORARY REASSIGNMENT OF DIVISION “P” CASES

WHEREAS, the number of cases currently assigned to Division “P” significantly exceeds the number appropriate for its designation as a half Family Law division; and

WHEREAS, having an excessive case load adversely impacts the time available to address the daily docket demands of Division “P;” and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to temporarily adjust the case load of Division “P;” it is hereby,

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that:

1. This directive shall not apply to domestic violence, repeat violence, dating violence, sexual violence, and stalking violence cases.
2. This directive shall not apply to newly filed cases where the Petitioner and the Respondent had a previous case assigned to Division “P.”
3. Effective June 1, 2015, through and including June 15, 2015, no newly filed cases shall be assigned to Division “P.”
4. Effective August 17, 2015, through and including August 31, 2015, no newly filed cases shall be assigned to Division “P.”

5. During the times referenced in paragraphs 3 and 4 above, all reassigned cases shall be divided between Divisions “L” and “M” equally, with no adjustment made to the percentages of cases assigned to Divisions “SL,” “SM,” “SP,” “YL,” “YM,” and “YP.”
