ORDER

WHEREAS, among the requirements of the Chief Judge in Rule 2.215(b), *Florida Rules of Judicial Administration*, the Chief Judge is to develop a plan “compatible with the development of the capabilities of the judges in such a manner that each judge will be qualified to serve in any division, thereby creating a judicial pool from which judges may be assigned to various courts throughout the state;” and

WHEREAS, the undersigned was appointed as Administrative Judge in Escambia County in AO2017-33; and

WHEREAS, the undersigned is acting under the authority of the Chief Judge; it is

ORDERED that:

1. Effective January 8, 2019, Escambia Circuit Judge John L. Miller shall be assigned to preside in Escambia Family Law Division “L.”
2. Effective January 8, 2019, Escambia Circuit Judge Jennie Kinsey shall be assigned to preside in Escambia Mental Health Division “R.”
3. Effective January 8, 2019, Escambia Circuit Judge Jeffrey L. Burns shall be assigned to preside in Escambia Division “F.”

4. Effective January 8, 2019, Escambia Circuit Judge Lacey Powell Clark shall be assigned to preside in Escambia Division "J."
