IN RE: DISTRIBUTION OF PETITIONS FOR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE
AND REPEAT VIOLENCE INJUNCTIONS

WHEREAS, a great number of petitions for domestic violence and repeat violence injunctions are filed in Escambia County; and

WHEREAS, the interests of judicial economy and justice demand that such petitions be addressed efficiently and expeditiously, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court shall present for judicial consideration all future petitions for domestic violence and repeat violence injunctions in the following manner:

1. To the family law judge to whom the case has been assigned, and if that judge is unavailable;
2. To any other family law judge who is available, and if no family law judge is available;
3. To the acting duty judge, and if the duty judge is unavailable;
4. To any other circuit or county judge.
