IN RE: NOTICE REQUIRED FOR PLACING CASES ON CRIMINAL DOCKET

In order for a case to be placed on the criminal docket for a hearing on a motion, or otherwise, notice must be given to the Clerk of the Court at least three (3) working days before the date of the hearing.

The three (3) working days notice may be waived with leave of Court as needed.

The provisions of this Directive shall be effective immediately.
