**ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTIVE WCAD 1993-01**

**IN RE: COURT ORDERED PAYMENTS WHILE ON SUPERVISION  
PAYABLE THROUGH DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTIONS**

Effective May 17, 1993, all defendants placed under the supervision of the Department of Corrections by the Circuit Court in Walton County will submit all court ordered payments by money order directly to the Department of Corrections, Probation & Parole Services, 311 West Nelson Avenue, DeFuniak Springs, Florida 32433, instead of to the individual victims or Clerk of Court.

Those defendants sentenced prior to May 17, 1993, shall in the future submit their payments by money order to the Probation Office in the area where they are currently being supervised. However, the exception being those individuals who are presently living in another state and being monitored by the Florida Department of Corrections, Probation & Parole Services, shall make their payments to 311 West Nelson Avenue, DeFuniak Ssprings, Florida 32433.

No direct payments from defendants under supervision will be receipted by the Clerk of Court of Walton County after June 1, 1993.
